Anita Patrick Memorial Bursary

PacificSport Regional Sport Centre – Interior BC acknowledges the significant contribution of the late Anita Patrick, Sport Massage Therapist. Her dedication to sport and care of high performance athletes was unprecedented. Anita was a Sport Massage Therapist in Kamloops and was a team therapist for the Canadian Rowing Team, Sprint Canoe/Kayak and Whitewater Canoe/Kayak Teams. She was selected to provide her expertise at 4 Olympic Games (1988, 1992, 1996 and 2000).

To honour the contributions made by Anita Patrick, PacificSport will provide financial assistance to a sport medicine or sport science practitioner. The purpose of this award is to encourage sport medicine and sport science practitioners to further their education (see criteria list below). Specifically, the financial assistance is provided to help offset travel expenses, exam fees, and other costs that may be incurred. Certification courses will normally be given higher priority for consideration than professional development opportunities.

Applications, based on the attached ***Application Form – Anita Patrick Memorial Bursary***, are to be submitted to the General Manager, PacificSport Regional Sport Centre – Interior BC. Selection of award recipients will be based on the following criteria:

- a. ATHLETIC THERAPISTS – Successful certification with the Canadian Athletic Therapists Association (CATA);
- b. CHIROPRACTORS - Successful completion of the Canadian College of Chiropractic Sport Sciences (CCSS);
- c. MASSAGE THERAPISTS – Successful completion of CSMTA Level II or CSMTA Level III;
- d. MENTAL TRAINERS – Registered with the CMTA;
- e. PHYSICIANS – Successful completion of the CASM diploma;
- f. PHYSIOTHERAPISTS – Successful completion of Level 2 or working towards Level 3.
- g. STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING SPECIALISTS – Successful completion of the CSCS exam;
- h. FITNESS APPRAISERS – Successful completion of the Professional Fitness and Lifestyle Consultants Course (PFLC);
- i. Good standing with the respective association;
- j. The maximum annual allocation of funds will not exceed \$500.00 to any one practitioner; and
- k. Practitioners may only apply once during the Regional Centre's fiscal year (April 1 – March 31).

The Sport Medicine and Science Advisory Committee will consider all applications in the Interior region (Kamloops, Salmon Arm, Revelstoke, Merritt, Clearwater, Barriere, Blue River and 100 Mile. The Board of Directors of PacificSport – Interior BC, will approve those applications recommended for financial assistance by the Committee. The decisions made by the Board are final. The annual allocation of funds will depend on the amount and availability of funds.
