MyoPalpation Instructor (Course placement- Year 1 Term 2)

Overview: Instructor will guide students in developing fascial treatment skills including assessment, stacking, cross hands and levering.

Primary Responsibilities include:

- Delivery of course curriculum through a combination of lecture, power point, demonstration, practical labs, and use of a learning management software (moodle)
- Delivering engaging in-class or moodle lectures covering principles of clinical assessment with application to massage therapy.
- Conducting all classes in accordance with course outline, the class schedule, and all instructional materials adopted for the course.
- Developing presentations, formative and/or summative assessments, and exercises that will help foster the student learning experience.
- Communicating via moodle and email
- Mentoring students in a classroom and virtual setting
- Motivating students to actively participate in all aspects of the educational process.
- Providing students with educational support and effective study strategies
- Collaboratively working with faculty to improve course delivery, resources, and curriculum
- Administering and supervising all tests quizzes and assignment
- Monitoring student progress, marking written and practical tests. Communicating with TA
- Maintaining complete and accurate records of students' grades and daily attendance.
- Recording and submission of grades to the appropriate personnel/software in a timely manner within the outlined time at the end of the course.
- Being available for student support within a reasonable timeline (48hr response to email, and reasonable access prior to or after class)
- Evaluating student performance in a manner consistent with the course objectives and grading criteria published in the course outline.
- Referring students to appropriate College resources for information or advising, as appropriate.
- Participating in the evaluation of course or curricula and making recommendations to the practical department.
- Maintaining RMT status in good standing.
- Exhibiting professional communication and behavior while at the campus or when representing the school in the community.
- Treating all staff and students equally with respect free from bias or discrimination.
- Maintaining current certification in first aid and CPR.
- Completing, or Willingness to complete adult education teacher training (required). Recent experience in instruction is preferred.
- Providing instruction for the full period scheduled, (schedule will be given in advance for feedback)
- Participating in scheduled faculty meetings.
- Attending all required faculty/staff meetings and graduation ceremonies.
